

Pyramat[®] Reduces Environmental Impact At Nevada Walmart

Location: Carson City, Nevada

Usage: Pyramat was used to control erosion on 1.5:1 slopes.

Notes: Walmart, in Douglas County, was adjacent to a field owned by the Paiute Tribe and an environmentally sensitive stream, Clear Creek, in Carson City. Both Carson City and the Paiute Tribe warned Walmart that if any sediment reached their respective properties, Walmart would be fined. Walmart chose to armor their steep slopes with Pyramat Tan because of Pyramat’s ability to blend in with the native soil while offering permanent erosion protection. Slopes now are 50% vegetated and the Pyramat Tan is not visible.
